DAERA reminds holidaymakers - don't risk it, leave it behind



The Department of Agriculture, Environment and Rural Affairs has issued a reminder to holidaymakers travelling abroad not to bring any animal or plant products back into Northern Ireland. This is essential in order to limit risks to the agri-food industry and to the environment, as any introduction of pests, diseases and non-native species can have a potentially devastating impact.

Ecosystems can be disrupted with significant knock-on effects on agriculture and the local economy.

Wood packaging material import requirements into Northern Ireland

Importers of goods of all kinds with wood packaging material which includes solid wood pallets and wood to support goods during transport need to be aware that there are import requirements.
